# -GHJA-Horsemanship Test

#### **Specifications**

GHJA is please to host the annual horsemanship test. This will be a written test created by members of the GHJA Board of Directors, local professionals and referencing to the USHJA TCP/ EAP manual. The written test will take place Friday November 17, 2023 from 2:00 – 4:00 PM in the Concession Stand during GHJA Finals. Upon completion of the written test in three different age groups (11 & Under, 12-14 and 15-17) the four top scoring candidates in each age group will schedule a hands-on practicum session at the finals. If you do not have a horse or association with a farm at the finals one will be provided for you.

Remember you must be a member of GHJA to participate in the test and must include your GHJA number on the test. No cell phones will be permitted while taking the test and you may use the full 2-hour window if needed. This is a great opportunity to show your horsemanship skills. You do not need to be showing at the finals or even horse show at all! Horsemanship does not begin and end in the tack. GHJA will award 1st through 8th place at the 2024 GHJA banquet. The top three winners will also receive grants. Winners will be notified prior to the 2024 banquet.

# -GHJA-Charity Jumper Challenge

#### **Specifications**

Teams are made up of 3 riders. Maximum of one professional on each team. Professionals are allowed to compete on a maximum of 2 teams. Juniors and amateurs are limited to one team only.

The course will be made up of 3 consecutive courses. 7 obstacles will be ridden at .85M, followed by 7 obstacles at .95M, followed by 7 obstacles at 1.10M. It will be judged as one course of 21 obstacles under Table III faults converted with 2 seconds added for each knockdown.

Riders will have 30 seconds to enter the ring and get set. A tone will sound and the rider #1 will have 15 seconds to break the timers at fence #1 before the clock starts automatically.

Entry fee \$300/team 50% of money raised will go to GHJA 50% of money raised will go to the winning team's charity of choice

#### **Class Scoring Clarifications**

2 seconds added for each rail

4 seconds added total for a refusal with a knockdown 5 seconds will be added in the event that the next team member in sequence leaves the ground jumping fence #8 or #15 before the previous team members horses front two feet land from fence #7 or #14 respectively.
15 seconds will be added for any fall of a horse or rider. The clock will stop. A tone will sound when it is safe for the next team member to take over in the course where the previous team member fell.

Each rider is permitted only two refusals. If rider #1 or #2 is eliminated for two refusals or a fall of horse or rider the next team member in sequence is responsible for taking over in the course where the previous team member left off. If rider #3 is eliminated the team will not receive a score for the class.

Teams are required to dress up in costume and to submit a music request to be played during their course.

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

The GHJA Grand Finale & Finals Horse Show is a local member show of the Georgia Hunter Jumper Association, Inc., and is operated in accordance with the current rules of GHJA. Every person who participates in the show is responsible for knowledge of and is subject to the rules of the GHJA. Participants have access to a copy of the current rule GHJA rule book at www.ghja.org. No points will count toward year-end awards until membership dues have been paid and horse is registered with GHJA.

- Horses and ponies may enter no more than seven "over fences" classes per show day, no more than five of which can be Jumper classes per day. All warm-up trips and special classes, such as equitation medals, hunter classics, derbies, and stakes classes are included in this total. All Jumper classics, stakes, warm-ups, and clear round classes shall count toward the limit of five Jumper classes.
- An ASTM/SEI approved helmet with a snuglyfitted chin strap is required of all riders (junior, amateur, and professional) at all times when mounted anywhere on the show grounds.
- Proper attire is required in all classes.
- Any verbal or physical act of discourtesy toward a Judge, Show Official, staff or crewmember, or equestrian center employee on the part of a trainer, owner, rider, groom, family member, or person associated with an entry will immediately disqualify that entry and all fees will be forfeited.
- Every adult competitor, parent or trainer must sign entry forms. Entrants are responsible for recording their GHJA numbers on the entry blank.
- Classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted.
- Ponies must possess a current GHJA or USEF measurement card to be presented at check-in, or they must be measured by the show Steward before their first pony performance class (pony hunter, jumper, equitation or medal).
- Unlicensed Drivers are not permitted to operate motorized vehicles of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds. Failure to abide by these regulations will subject the exhibitor to suspension from the horse show. USEF GR 1301.7.

- contained, at all times while on competition grounds. Said leash must be no more than 6 feet in length, and must be held in hand or secured to an immobile fixture. Retractable leashes must be locked at a length of 6 feet or less. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Loose and/or disruptive dogs may be subject to impoundment by the horse show or by the local government. Owners of loose and/or disruptive dogs may be subject to penalties and/or fines under GHJA Rules 18 and 19. Warning cards may be issued to such dog owners, an accumulation of which shall result in further penalties.
- Champion and Reserve ribbons will be awarded in each hunter division and jumper division, as well as ribbons for 1st through 8th place in each class. Jumper and Age Group Equitation classes will be pinned to 8th place. If points for Champion and Reserve Champion are awarded in the Age Group Equitation classes, they do not apply for GHJA annual awards.
- Exhibitors agree to show under a substitute judge if necessary.
- Show management reserves the right to cancel or change classes for the betterment of this show.
- The GHJA Grand Finale & Finals Horse Show, their employees and officials shall not be held responsible for any accident or injury which might occur to persons, horses or to any property while attending the shows, nor will they be responsible for any personal article which may be lost, stolen or destroyed.
- Entries: Closing dates for the GHJA Finale is November 7, 2023 - AFTER THAT DATE ALL STALL FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE, ENTRIES SUBJECT TO CLOSE EARLIER DEPENDENT ON STABLING AVAILABILITY

#### **GHJA Class Specifications**

#### **Hunter Over Fences**

To be shown over at least eight fences at the required height. To be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise stated.

#### Hunter Under Saddle

To be shown at a walk, trot and canter. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. Martingales not permitted.

#### Courses

Hunter courses will simulate fences found in the hunt field such as brush, wall, in-and-out, oxer, post and rails, gate, aiken, bank, coop and panels.

All hunter divisions will be held in accordance with GHJA rules. Hunter Divisions with less than 3 entries may be combined. Pony must possess and present to the office a GHJA or USEF measurement card to compete in any Pony Hunter division.

#### **Equitation Classes**

#### Short Stirrup Equitation

Open to qualified Short Stirrup rider. Fence height 2'.

#### **Long Stirrup Equitation**

Open to qualified Long Stirrup riders. Fence height 2'3".

#### Equitation 11 & under

Open to Juniors whose 12th birthday is not before December 1, 2022. Fence height 2'. No straight lines may be set at less than 60'.

#### Equitation 12-14

Open to Juniors whose 15th birthday is not before December 1, 2022. Fence height 2'6". No straight lines may be set at less than 60'.

#### Equitation 15-17

Open to Juniors whose 18th birthday is not before December 1, 2022. Fence height 3'

#### **Adult Equitation**

Open to all Adult Amateurs. Fence height 3'

#### **GHJA Equitation Challenge**

#### GHJA Equitation Challenge

GHJA Equitation Challenge Finals: The top 20 riders who have accumulated points throughout the year will qualify to ride in the Final Phase of the Challenge at the GHJA Finals Horse Show. To be judged at a walk, trot, and canter. Riders will be asked to perform any two or more of the USEF tests 1, 2, 10, 13, 15, 17 & 18. The judge may then require the top 4 riders to perform any two or more of the following tests: 2, 3, 5, 6, 10, 11, 14, 15, 17, 18, 19, 20 & 23. (Note: no more than twelve horses may counter canter at one time). Martingales are not permitted. Riders receiving outside assistance or coaching while in the arena will be eliminated. Riders who have won the final GHJA Equitation Challenge in the previous three years are no longer eligible to compete in this class. November 1st is the cut-off date for riding in qualifying classes at shows.

#### **Medal Classes**

#### Specifications for GHJA Medals

To be shown over a modified jumper-type course of at least 8 fences. The course must include at least one oxer and one change of direction. Height of fences shall be 3' for Juniors on horses and Amateurs. Height shall be 2' for Juniors on small ponies, 2'3' for Juniors on medium ponies and 2'6" for Juniors on large ponies. All straight lines must be measured to accommodate a 12' stride with no straight lines to be set at less than 60'. To be judged on seat, hands, guidance and control of the horse. A minimum of 6 riders will be required to show at a walk, trot and canter. The under saddle performance of selected riders shall count 25%. The Judges may request riders to perform any of Tests 1-23 (see Appendix B of the GHJA Rule Book).

#### GHJA Pony Medal

Ponies with measurement cards to be ridden by Junior riders. Small ponies to be ridden by Junior riders 12 years of age or under to be jumped at 2'. Medium ponies to be ridden by Junior riders 14 years of age or under to be jumped by 2'3". Large ponies ridden by Juniors to be jumped at 2'6".

#### J.D. Pounds Junior Medal

Open to Juniors on horses. Fence height 3'.

#### Laura Tison Adult Medal

Open to Adult Amateurs on horses or ponies. Fence height 3'. Ponies may not be shown by a junior in any other classes.

#### Mini Medals 2'3 and 2'9"

To be shown over a modified jumper type course of at least 8 fences. The course must include at least one oxer and one change of direction. Open to juniors and amateurs on horses or ponies.

GHJA Medals can be combined if there are fewer than 3 in any of the medals. However rider/horse must jump at appropriate fence height.

#### **Jumper Classes**

#### .80 m (2'7") Jumper

Open to all riders on horses or ponies.

#### Low Child/Adult Jumper .85 m (2'9")

Open to Children and Adult Amateur riders on horses or ponies. Horse/rider combination may not cross enter into classes higher than .90m at the same horse show.

#### .90 m (2'll") Jumper

Open to all riders on horses or ponies.

#### Child/Adult Jumper .95 m (3'1")

Open to Junior and Adult Amateur riders on horses or ponies. Horse/ rider combination may not cross enter into classes higher than 1.10m at the same horse show.

#### 1.00 m (3'3") Jumper

Open to all riders on horses or ponies.

#### 1.10 m (3'7") Jumper

Open to all riders on horses or ponies.

#### **Hunter Classes**

#### Pre-Children's Hunter

Open to Junior riders on horses or ponies; horse/rider combination may not have competed at 3'3" or higher at any Local or Regular Member horse show in the previous 3 years. Fence height 2'6". Horse rider combo MAY NOT cross enter into children's hunter.

#### Pre-Adult Hunter

Open to Adult Amateur riders on horse or ponies; horse/rider combination may not have competed at 3'3" or higher at any Local or Regular Member horse show in the previous 3 years. Fence height 2'6". Horse Rider Combo MAY NOT cross enter into Adult hunter.

#### **Modified Hunter**

Open to all horses or ponies ridden by juniors, amateurs or professionals. Fence height 2'9".

#### Open Hunter

Open to all horses or ponies ridden by juniors, amateurs or professionals. Fence height 2'6" or 3'. Rider may show at either height group at rider's or trainer's discretion.

#### Children's Hunter

Open to all horses ridden by a Junior. Fence height 3'. Horse/rider combo MAY NOT cross enter into Pre-Children's Hunter.

#### **Adult Amateur Hunter**

Open to Adult Amateur riders on horses or ponies. A pony ridden in the Adult Amateur Hunters may not cross enter into any Pony Hunter division or Junior Equitation classes or Junior Medal at the same show. Fence height 3'. Horse/rider combo MAY NOT cross enter into Pre-Adult Hunter

#### Performance Hunter 3'3"/3'6"

Open to all riders on horses.

#### Schooling Pony

Open to Junior riders only on ponies. Fence height 2' or 2'6". May jump either height at the rider's or trainer's discretion.

#### Small Ponv Hunter

Open to Junior riders 12 years of age or under on ponies not to exceed 12.2 hh. Fence height 2'.

#### **Medium Pony Hunter**

Open to Junior riders 14 years of age or under on ponies over 12.2 hh, but not to exceed 13.2 hh. Fence height 2'3".

#### Large Pony Hunter

Open to Junior riders on ponies that do not exceed 14.2 hh. Fence height 2'6".

#### Long Stirrup Hunter

Open to Junior and Amateur riders ages 13 years and older on horses or ponies, in the rider's first or second year of showing over fences higher than 18" in any horse show. Riders may show in Long Stirrup for two consecutive show years. Eligibility is determined by the rider, without regard to horse-rider combination. Riders must adhere to the following parameters at all GHJA locally sanctioned and USEF recognized shows: (i) Long Stirrup eligible riders may enter or cross-enter into only hunter classes or divisions that are unrecognized by GHJA or USEF. Fence height not to exceed 2'6"; (ii) Long Stirrup eligible riders may enter or cross-enter into age group equitation divisions that do not to exceed 2'6" in height; (iii) Long Stirrup eligible riders may not enter or cross-enter into GHJA or USEF recognized Medal classes; (iv) Long Stirrup eligible riders may only enter or cross-enter in Jumper classes at or below 0.70 m. Fence height 2'3". See current GHJA Rule Book for further clarification regarding eligibility."

#### Green Hunter

2'3" or 2'6" at the discretion of show management; Open to horses and ponies in their first or second year of showing over fences higher than 2' at any show. A horse or pony's eligibility is limited to two consecutive show years during which time the horse or pony may not show in any division with fences higher than 2'6" or it will lose its Green status. Horses or ponies may be ridden by juniors, amateurs, or professionals. A pony ridden by an adult or professional rider may not cross enter into any Pony Hunter, Junior Equitation, or Junior Medal class at the same show.

#### Short Stirrup Hunter

Open to riders ages 12 years and under, on horses or ponies, in their first or second year of showing over fences higher than 18" in any horse show. Riders may show in Short Stirrup classes for two consecutive years. The two years of eligibility may not be separated or divided in any manner. Short and Long Stirrup eligibility are counted together when age eligibility overlaps during the two years: a rider may compete in Short and/or Long Stirrup Divisions for a total of two consecutive show years. Eligibility is determined by the rider, without regard to horse-rider combination. The rider must adhere to the following parameters at all GHJA locally sanctioned and USEF recognized shows: (i) Short Stirrup eligible riders may enter or cross-enter into only hunter classes or divisions that are unrecognized by GHJA or USEF. Fence height not to exceed 2'3"; (ii) Short Stirrup eligible riders may enter or crossenter into age group equitation divisions that do not to exceed 2'6" in height; (iii) Short Stirrup eligible riders may not enter or crossenter into GHJA or USEF recognized Medal classes; (iv) Short Stirrup eliqible riders may only enter or cross-enter in Jumper classes at or below 0.65m. Fence height 2'. See current GHJA Rule Book for further clarification regarding eligibility.

#### Hunter Derby

The Derby classes are open to all exhibitors. Horse/rider combination must have jumped comparable fence height during the show. The class will consist of two rounds with the first round being a classic hunter round with a minimum of 10 obstacles with at least two of the following: Bending line, long approach, one line with an unrelated distance, and option jumps no higher than 3" than the designated fence height. The second round will be a Handy Hunter round with a minimum of 8 obstacles. A Handy Hunter course is designed to encourage and reward brilliance and thoughtfulness. The course will have a minimum of two handy options such as : varying tracks with optional tight turns, trot or hand gallop fence, halt or halt and back, and optional jumps no higher than 3" higher than the designated fence height. Options used will be at the discretion of show management. The top 14 riders from round 1 will return for round 2. Scores from the two rounds are combined for the final score. First place award and ribbons 1st-12th. Points will be awarded to designated class of comparable fence height only if a declaration form has been filled out at the office no later than noon of November 18th.

#### Silver Stirrup Hunter

Open to adult amateur riders, 35 years of age and older, who have not shown in classes with fence heights 2'6" or higher in the past three (3) years. Fence height 2', no oxers.

#### Thoroughbred Hunter

Open to any registered Thoroughbred, ridden by juniors, amateurs, or professional riders. Fence height 2'6" or 2'9" at the discretion of show management. Non-registered Thoroughbred horses may apply for approved eligibility by submitting reliable proof of pedigree to GHJA.
